The Mount Rigi massif rises up – like a majestic pre-Alpine peninsula between Lake Lucerne, Lake Zug, and Lake Lauerz. The vast expanse of the area makes it a perfect place for guests to explore. Since 1871, steam trains have been climbing the Queen of the Mountains, offering their passengers a truly first-class railway experience. The main transport hubs for travel onto Mount Rigi are the stations at Vitznau, Weggis, and Arth-Goldau. At 1800 meters above sea level at Rigi Kulm, guests are afforded a breathtaking 360-degree panorama with a view of up to 620 alpine peaks and 13 lakes.
